## IN THE VINEYARD

Organically grown  
Wine of Origin: Stellenbosch  
Situation: North-Northwest row orientation, high density vineyard blocks of 5,600 vines per hectare  
Altitude: 200m  
Soil: Decomposed granite  
Age of vines: Planted in 2009  
Trellising: Vertical shoot positioning  
Pruning: Cordon (spur pruning)  
Irrigation: Drip

## IN THE CELLAR

The hand-harvested grapes were whole bunch pressed directly to tank and inoculated. After a “dirty fermentation” (without any settling of the juice) at 15°C, the wine was racked off its lees, filtered to clarify and bottled.

## TASTING NOTES

Crafted from 100% Petit Verdot, this fresh and lively rosé is packed with bright red berry and watermelon flavors, with delicate floral notes that shine through on the refreshingly dry finish.

RS: 1 g/l  
pH: 3.54
